





Waiver Overview

- ✓ SOURCE (Service Options Using Resources in a Community Environment) Waiver is for adults 65 or older. Adults may have chronic illnesses or be disabled. Must be eligible for nursing home facility.
- ✓ ICWP (Independent Care Waiver Program) is for individuals between 21 and 64 with tramautic brain injuries and serious physical disabilities. Participants get skilled nursing care at home.
- NOW (New Options Waiver) program is for those with developmental disabilities and special needs. Progam supports those with special needs requiring support for care needs.
- CCSP (Community Care Services Program) is for elderly care and helps seniors remain in their own homes. Participants could be candidates for nursing home care.
- ✓ COMP (Comprehensive Support) is for people with developmental, social, physical, and emotional disabilities like cerebral palsy or autism. Recipients could receive in-home care.
- ✓ GAPP (Georgia Pediatric Program) is for children, infants and adults under 2. Participants have serious medical injuries and have been identified as medically fragile.

How Payments Work

Scenario 1

Eligible participants receive full assistance for their care needs. The medical condition is recognized by an entity or medical provider, and all of the costs are covered if eligible for the waiver.

Scenario 2

A qualifying condition is required. Eligible participants receive some financial assistance and are responsible for covering additional costs out of pocket. This refers to cost-sharing.
